When will Cornerstone College Amarillo begin?

Orientation at 7 pm August 31st at Cornerstone Church Amarillo

The school year begins on Tuesday, September 7, 2010 and ends on Tuesday, May 24, 2011.

First Quarter: September 7th - November 2nd

Third Quarter: January 18th - March 15th

Classes meet from 7:00 pm to 9:35 pm on Tuesdays at Cornerstone Church Amarillo, located at 6th and Tennessee.

How much does Cornerstone College Amarillo cost?

The tuition for Cornerstone College Amarillo is \$1,305 a year. This can be paid on a nine-month basis at \$145.00 per month. There is also a \$100 registration fee.

Registration and first month's tuition are due at the first class. Tuition is due on the 5th of each month.

Student Conduct

All students admitted to Cornerstone College Amarillo are expected to refrain from social dancing and the use of tobacco, alcohol, and other habit forming and/or illegal drugs. Dress Code

At Cornerstone College Amarillo, we uphold the highest standards of morality and decency while building a spirit of excellence into each student's life. Modesty and Christian virtue should be at the heart of what every student desires to exhibit in his/ her dress.

Ladies: Dress pants, cotton pants, blouses, sweaters, shirts, dresses, and skirts are appropriate for classes at Cornerstone College Amarillo. No jeans or T-shirts.

Men: Dress pants, cotton pants (e.g. dockers), dress shirts, collared T-shirts (e.g. polo shirts) are appropriate for classes at Cornerstone College Amarillo. No jeans or T-shirts.

Low rise pants, short and/or form fitting low cut tops, baggy, low hanging pants, and provocative, lewd clothing is not permitted.

The student's clothing should be modest, neat, clean, well-fitting, and in good repair. If a difference of opinion should arise, the student should yield to the judgment of the administration.
